### Guidelines

<b>TARGET GROUP</b>	Recent NAISDA Graduate
<b>SELECTION PROCESS</b>	Competitive two stage application process
<b>DESIRED OUTCOME</b>	Transition to more study; additional industry training
<b>GRANT AMOUNT</b>	Determined through discussion with LGI

#### CRITERIA

- Must be a recent NAISDA Graduate.

#### APPLICATION PROCESS

NAISDA will provide you with confirmation of receipt of your application. Your application will be checked for eligibility against the requirements in these guidelines.

#### SUPPORT MATERIAL

You will need to provide the following support material:

- Resume (limit: 2 pages)
- Links to your most recent work (limit: 5 minutes, please identify yourself in the work if you are performing)
- Letter of support from professional arts institution, artist, mentor, community member or other
- Reviews of past work, links to websites, blogs, YouTube etc

#### ASSESSMENT CRITERIA

Your application will be assessed against the following criteria:

- The artistic merit of your work ( as evidence by support material)
- The demonstrated benefit of your program to your practice at this time in your career

# Review Process

Once your application has been received NAISDA will review your submission and if the panel finds the application fits the criteria, your application will be shortlisted to be assessed by Lucy Guerin Inc for final selection, this may include a phone interview with Lucy Guerin and a Melbourne-based First Nations mentor.

### SELECTION PANEL STAGE ONE

The assessment panel for this Internship will be made up of:

- NAISDA CEO (facilitator)
- NAISDA Head of Dance
- 1 External professional senior Indigenous dance artist (this may be someone who teaches at NAISDA, but not on a regular basis)

### INTERNSHIP CONDITIONS

- LGI will provide the Intern an Award-level wage, per diems, and accommodation for up to five (5) weeks' full-time engagement in Melbourne, plus two return economy airfares from NSW – Melbourne during the program. LGI will negotiate individual needs with Interns, including the option for LGI to book relevant travel arrangements, or to provide a travel allowance at an agreed value.
- Provide the Intern with access to various LGI programs free-of-charge, including but not limited to, company rehearsals, professional classes, and HOTBED workshops (scheduling dependent).
- Offer the Intern digital check-ins with LGI before, during, and after the internship period, in order to support deeper engagement across the program.
- Provide the Intern with access to an appropriate mentor (agreed upon by intern, LGI and NAISDA), who will support cultural safety and networking during the program.
- Invite the Intern to participate in the selection process for the following year's Internship Program.

### FUNDING TERM/RESTRICTIONS:

- The funding term is available for professional development activities as agreed between the recipient and LGI.
- Applications open on Tuesday 27th October and close Thursday 12th November .
- The successful applicant will be notified ASAP after submission close.
